Vision



- A platform for beautiful modular housing generated and refined by AI.
- Homes that feel safe and restorative, delivered with factory speed.
- Licensing network of builders for rapid, global deployment.

Problem



- Housing is either fast or beautiful; the world needs both.
- Climate events and displacement outpace conventional construction.
- Buyers want trust and taste without bespoke architect timelines.

Solution



- Viral, data-validated designs \rightarrow orderable kits \rightarrow licensed manufacturing.
- Inventory-light IP model with high margins and faster scale.
- A design language attuned to neuroarchitecture and wellbeing.





Business Model



- Design IP: kits and licenses to individuals, institutions, and partners.
- Enterprise: pilots with defense, emergency response, and hospitality.
- Media + commerce: content, digital plans, and affiliate channels.

Traction



- 1M+ organic impressions across Pinterest, TikTok, and YouTube.
- Printables MVP: 40+ plan downloads within 24 hours.
- \$43K revenue from consulting and product sales; founder-bootstrapped.
- Growing pipeline of manufacturing and deployment partners.

Roadmap (12–18 months)



- Sign 3 licensed builders across NA + EU; launch first paid pilots.
- Direct ordering with financing; first 50 units shipped.
- Expand SKUs (ADUs, domes, trailers) with standardized components.

The Ask



- Seed round: \$1.5M for 18 months runway.
- Use of funds: productization, engineering, licenses/pilots, IP, working capital.
- Milestones: licensed partners signed, pilots executed, revenue ramp.
